Pilot launched, challenging mobility landscape...





- Internal test MoveBrussels August 2020, launch panel testing (+-2K) mid September 2020
- MoveBrussels test during 2021 while continuing onboarding new MSPs & enlarging panel
- Beyond UX-UI feedback, nudging to get insights about power of digital app to create Modal Shift
- Launch "MaaS solution-for-all" H1 2022, public tender to be published March 2021







... leading to limited insights yet from test panel

- Limited mobility during quarantine period impacts negatively Pilot insights
- SoMe community very dynamic & interactive
- Focus groups help gaining specific feedback about current app and expectations
- Testing of hypotheses via missions to be executed rewarded by incentives & gamification

- "I am a regular PTO user but using the app I discovered a De Lijn bus was even much better for the trip I was planning"
- "Centralised payment to access almost mobility services is a must to ease inter-modality"
- Panellists convinced "showing savings vs car usage is a modal shift driver" (expense, time, CO2)
- "Walking is often more efficient than have a PTO trip"
- "It is pleasant to feel we have mobility alternatives"
- Tracking & tracing up to certain level
